In that capacity over the last five years we learned of the great need such owners and renters have for equitable treatment when it comes to purchasing and maintaining their homes.

Their market is definitely underserved and the above cited rulemaking process is well overdue. Locally in Salt lake City and the throughout the state we find homeowners and renters living in "mobile home" parks have little or no rights compared to typical homeowners.

We could recite dozens if not hundreds of sad, tragic stories about the inequities suffered by this mostly unsubsidized population.

However, it should be sufficient for the purposes of this rulemaking to say we readily endorse the comments made to you by Andrea Levere, President of the Corporation for Enterprise Development.
